# FUTURITY DERBY/MATURITY RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. **By entering** all contestants agree to abide by and follow all rules. Thar Ranch Productions reserves the right to refuse entry to any horse or individual.

2. **Futurity** is open to horses foaled in 2019 and 2018 (4 and 5 years of age) Horses must have not competed in any barrel racing, including registered shows, open shows, play days, rodeos or other futurities prior to NOV, 11th 2022. To do so means to forfeit any and all fees paid and elimination from the futurity.

# 3. Futurity Nominations Fees

\$400.00 post marked or paid online – August 1, 2023 \*Onetime fee, no payments. Total \$400.00. Late fee after Aug. 1 \$150.

4. **Any payments** postmarked after due date, or paid online after due date will be considered late. Late fees will be \$150.00.

5. **The Fizz Bomb Futurity** format will be two go-rounds and average. The first round will be drawn, the second round will be run in reverse order.

6. Drags will be after every 5 runs and a big drag after every 50.

7. **Of the \$400** total entry fee, \$280 will be added to the purse, and \$120 will be retained as an office charge. \$20,000 will also be added toward the purse.

#### 8. Futurity Payout:

1D 100% added money and 80% of entry fees 30% to the first go-round 30% to the second go-round 40% to the Fastest Average
2D Futurity Incentive 20% of entry fee will be paid on a .75 split 30% to the first go-round 30% to the second go-round 40% to the Average

9. Horses running in the futurity may carry over to the open Friday and Saturday. Carryover entries and full payment must be received before horse runs in the futurity, and may be subject to late fees. Rider is responsible for checking their carryover entry and notifying the office. At the discretion of the committee, any missed carryovers that are NOT reported to the office be for the start of race will be refunded their carryover fee, but will not be issued any winnings or figured into the final results. \* Futurity entry may not carryover in to Wendy Larsen Sr. race.

# 10. Pole Bending 2D futurity \$250.00 added

Pole futurity is open to horses foaled in 2019 and 2018 (4 and 5 years of age). To be eligible for the pole futurity, the horse cannot have ever competed in any pole bending prior to Nov  $11^{th}$  2023.

Entry Fee is \$75, due Aug 1, 2022. Payments postmarked or paid online after Aug 2<sup>,</sup> 2021 will be late. Late payment fee is \$20. Late pole entries will be taken until 3 pm on the day of the event. (All late fees and drop out fees are retained by Thar Ranch Productions) - Pole Futurity will be a 2 D, with a 1.5 second split. Pole Futurity is a one go-round. Pole futurity horses running in the pole futurity may carryover time into the open 3D pole bending. Designate your carryover on the Open 4D entry form, and attach this form to any of your futurity payments. Carryover entries must be in before horse runs in the futurity, and may be subject to late fees. Carryover entries must be in before horse runs in pole futurity.



11. **Amateur futurity** prizes will be awarded to the champion and reserve champion amateur contestants. An "Amateur" Entry is a rider who has not won over \$500 in 1D futurity money prior to Nov 11<sup>th</sup> 2022. Amateurs may not have, or ever had a WPRA card or filled a WPRA permit. You must designate your amateur status on the enclosed entry form. Any entry form not marked is considered a "NO". Amateur rider may be asked to verify amateur status.

\$75.00 Entry Fee.

12. Home Grown 307 Quarter Horse - fastest time in avg. for futurity entry that has breed, raised, and owner will be running horse

13. **Derby/Maturity** is open to all horses foaled from 2015 to 2018 (5 to 8 years of age), as well as any horse that has been 100% paid up in a previous Fizz Bomb Futurity/Derby after 2009. Horses are not allowed to enter futurity and derby/maturity in the same year.

#### **Derby/Maturity Nomination Fee**

\$250.00 postmarked or paid online – Late Fee after Aug 1st, \$75.00

**\$250.00** total entry fee \$175.00 will be added to the purse, and \$75.00 will be retained as an office charge. \$3000 will also be added to the purse.

#### 14. Derby Payout:

1D 100% of added money plus 80% of entries.
30% to the first go-round
30% to the second go-round
40% to the average
2D 20% of entries (will be on a .75 split) 50% to the first go-round
50% to the second go-round
50% to the second go-round
Average prizes
There will be two go-rounds in the Derby. The first go-round will be

drawn and the second go-round will run in reverse order. Drags – There will be a drag after every 5 and a big drag after every 50.

\* Horses running in the Derby/Maturity may carryover to the open Friday and Saturday. Carryover entries must be received and paid in full before horse runs in the Derby/Maturity, and may be subject to late fees. Rider is responsible for checking their carryover entry and notifying the offices any missed entry or changes. At the discretion of the committee, any missed carryovers that are NOT reported to the office be for the start of race will be refunded their carryover fee, but will not be issued any winnings or figured into the final results. \* \* Derby entry may not carryover in to Wendy Larsen Sr. race.

## 15. Futurity, Derby/ Maturity Rules and Regulations:

a. A photocopy of the front of the registration papers of registered horses or veterinarian's affidavit of the year of birth along with a complete physical description of unregistered horses must accompany nominations. Entry will be considered LATE if the information does not accompany entry form, and will be subject to late fees.

- b. Owners may enter more than one horse. The owner does not have to ride his/her horse. All riders must be designated on or before September 1<sup>st</sup> rider changes after that date will be subject to a \$75 fee. No changes may be made following check-in. Should a nominated horse be sold during the course of the payment period, written authorization must be received from the original owner before horse can continue in the entry process. If no authorization is received entry in the futurity is void. Horses must be ridden by the same riders throughout the futurity and/or Derby/Maturity unless a professional release is received or there is obvious injury.
- c. Substitutions are allowed only due to illness, injury or death of the nominated horse. A veterinarian's affidavit of proof MUST accompany substitutions along with a \$25.00 fee. The necessary papers on the substitution horse must accompany the fee. Any substituted horse will be ridden by the originally nominated rider or owned by the original owner.
- d. **Buyouts/Refunds.** No buyouts.50% of entry fee refunded with a veterinary or physician affidavit. Request for refund must be made before the posting of the draw. No Exceptions.
- e. All Futurity and Derby/Maturity riders must be checked in before 10AM September 6th unless prior arrangements are made with the show secretary. Current 30 day health papers and coggins are required by out of state horses on, and recommended for in state horses.
- f. Disqualification Contestants must be ready when called. Failure to be in position in the holding area will result in a disqualification. Contestants must be present in holding pen during their set. If a horse runs out of order, it will be disqualified.
- g. Full Dress code Long sleeve shirt (no collar required), boots and cowboy hat or helmet are to be worn during all competition.
- h. Each knocked down barrel receives a 5 second penalty.
- i. Timers- Two electric timers will be used. Reruns will be given only in the event of a time malfunction. If a rerun is given, it will be up to the show manager to decide when the rerun will take place. Reruns will not be given for horses falling, contestant equipment breaking or for a rider's decision to pull up.
- j.  $2^{nd}$  Go is Reverse order. Lates will run FIRST the  $2^{nd}$  Go
- k. 1 Exhibition- 60 sec. maintain forward motion. Each futurity entry includes 1 exhibitions on Wednesday Sept 6<sup>th</sup>. Riders that go over 60 sec. will be charged a \$10 penalty.
- I. Zero Tolerance Policy Abuse includes but not limited to excessive jerking, spurring, whipping, slapping, abuse with a device or any other act intended to cause trauma or injury to a horse. In show arena, practice pen, or on show grounds. Any accusations of abuse will be reviewed by show committee. Abusers will be asked to leave show grounds forfeiting any and all fees or winnings.
- m. FUTURITY DERBY/ MATURITY Senior Race: 2D Format full sec. splits sidepot. Anyone 50+ as of Jan 1st of current year.



16. **INCENTIVE PROGRAMS** It is the responsibility of the contestant/owner to submit incentive program paperwork with their entry, and to confirm this carryover with the show office prior to competing. **TRP** - Fizz Bomb in not responsible for paying out incentive monies.

17. **FUTURE FORTUNES** Any FUTURE FORTUNES horse can be eligible for FUTURE FORTUNES bonus money at open events, regardless of age. To be eligible for Future Fortunes Bonus Money, refer to rule #3 under General Rules. FUTURE FORTUNES bonus money will be paid on the horse's first run for that event. All runs must be on same day. NO carry overs from another day. (Unless approved in advance by the Future Fortunes' office.) If you are allowed to enter more than one time, only your first run will count for Future Fortunes Bonus Money. To be paid on a 4D format based on the time of the fastest FUTURE FORTUNES eligible horse with ½ second splits between each division. A rider can ride more than one FUTURE FORTUNES horse in an Open event. All Future Fortunes Open Bonus Money will be run on Saturday unless otherwise noted.

18. **TRIPLE CROWN 100** A rider can ride more than on TRIPLE CROWN 100 foal in a futurity event. **TRIPLE CROWN 100** bonus money will be paid first go only paying top 4 places. Foal must be 5 years of age or under and never have competed in a barrel race prior to December 1st of the previous year

19. **BULE COLLAR BREEDERS** Foals that are conceived in the same year that the stallion is paid in and in good standing with Blue Collar Breeders Inc. will be eligible to compete for prize money. If a foal is conceived in a year that the stallion is paid in to the program and the stallion drops out the following year, the foal will be eligible to compete for the prize money as it was conceived in the year that stallion was enrolled. 20. **Tomorrow's Legends** All Tomorrow's Legends nominated horses are eligible for TL Payout at open events, regardless of age. TL Open Payout is a 4D equal pay with ½ second splits between each division.TL Will follow the rules of the event to which TL is side- potting, with the exception of knocked barrels - a knocked barrel will always result in a no-time and no-times are not subject to payout placing. TL will pay the placing amount only as listed in which a horse and rider team place. To clarify if only 3 horses place in the 1D, only placings for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd will be paid. The remaining monies (4th and 5th place) will be retained by TL and used towards adding a new payout event and 5th place) will be retained by TL and used towards adding a new payout event.
